Where commodity, product life cycle's or service's carbon footprint has been calculated and compensated.




- Driven by: 🗸 End-buyers targeting Net Zero in procurement

Many companies are gearing towards net zero ambitions. Being able to provide carbon neutral LNG to customers will create a competitive advantage over time."



Carbon Offset Certification is the first publicly available certification protocol for carbon neutral commodity transactions (cradle-to-gate or cradle-to-grave), products (cradle-to-shelf) or services with clear **separation of roles for credible environmental claims:**



Carbon Offset Certification protocol is based on reference standards for each step of the certification

process:

PAS2050, PAS2060, ISO14064, GHG Protocol, OGMP 2.0 ISO14025, PAS2050, PAS2060, ISO14064, ISO14069 GoldStandard, Verra, American Carbon Registry, etc. ISO14025, BS45011, ISO17021



Annex 1: Offsetting to neutralize residual emissions within a Reduction Plan



Aligned with the Paris Agreement, a robust reduction plan should be the priority to reach Net Zero objective.

Using quality carbon credits for carbon offsetting is the only solution to mitigate and neutralize residual emissions and claim for climate neutrality.

WWF: "Carbon credit purchases should only be made in addition to such a reduction strategy."

Carbon Disclosure Project (CDP): "Offsetting is increasingly a means for ambitious companies to demonstrate further commitment to climate change, playing a part in our wider efforts to urgently manage our impacts and supporting our ability to achieve net zero in time."



Annex 2: Certification process: How does it work?

Certification Process:

- 1 Identify commodity transaction, product or service for which the Carbon Offset Certification should apply.
- 2 **Calculate GHG emissions:** This can be done by the company itself or a third party expert in carbon footprint calculation. COC can introduce the company to expert carbon footprint calculation service providers.
- 3 **GHG report verification & third party assurance** of the GHG calculation process. Shall be done by a recognised verification body. CNC recommends Bureau Veritas, COC strategic partner.
- Offset: Acquire and cancel eligible carbon credits (cancellation to avoid double use) COC can explain carbon markets principles and introduce the company to carbon markets access providers.
- 5 Issuance of **Carbon Offset Commodity**, **Carbon Offset Product** or **Carbon Offset Service certificate**.
- 6) **Communicate** certification to partners.
